## WHAT ARE OPIATES?

Opiates are narcotics, and drugs in this category tend to make the user feel sleepy (downers), as opposed to energized (uppers). Many are powerful and can severely “numb” the user. As medication, opiates are used to relieve moderate to severe pain. People with chronic pain, cancer or those who are recovering from surgery may be prescribed these medications. Opiates include such medications as:

Codeine • Percocet  
 Morphine • Percodan  
 Oxycodone • Ultram  
 OxyContin • Vicodin

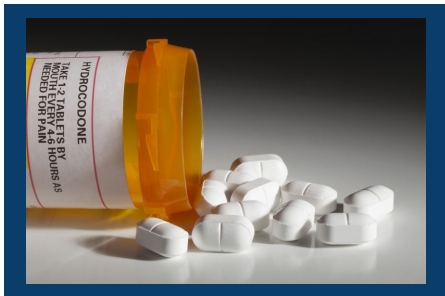
