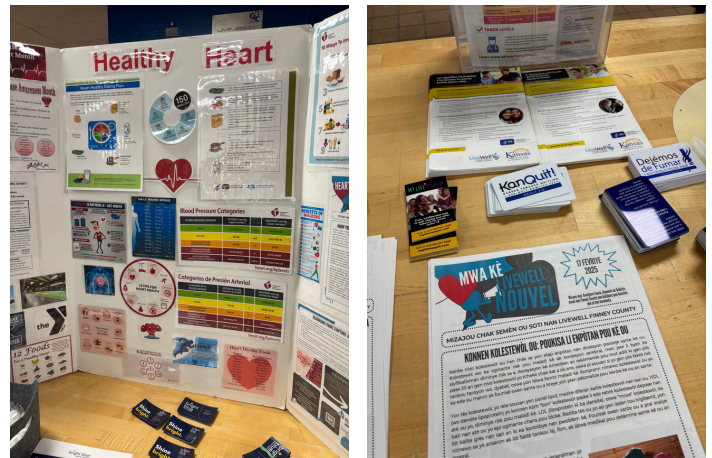

# ORGANIZATIONS AWARDED CITY COMMUNITY GRANTS

The City of Garden City has awarded a total of \$14,550 in Community Grant Funds to several local organizations. The funds will support Aim to Inspire Meliorism's Family Resource Fair, help Magic's HOPE cover transportation costs for therapy animals, enhance The Community's citizenship and civic engagement programming, and enable the Western Kansas Child Advocacy Center to develop a Forensic Medical Room for Sexual Assault Nurse Exams.
